

Camp Yowochas Activity Guide

FIRE BUILDING

An introduction to basic fire lighting technique, safety and leave-no-trace ethic. Participants will learn about the three elements required to make a fire; fuel, heat and air. Participants will also learn about tinder, kindling and fuel to keep their fire burning longer. Fire Building can be combined with outdoor cooking.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

This activity will be lead by a well trained Camp Yowochas staff member who will teach all safety techniques and skills. Fires are kept small and are built in established fire pit areas only. Water for extinguishing the fire is readily available and boundaries around fire are established. This activity is closely and constantly supervised.
